

**Pike County Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Fund  
COVID-19 Relief Block Grant  
Guidelines and Application**

Purpose of Funding

Pike County anticipates receiving \$5,040,047 in CARES Act funding through the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development. A portion of this funding will be made available to assist with the cost of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). This funding will be used to reimburse PPE expenditures incurred between March 31, 2020 and December 30, 2020 that are necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19).

Eligible Applicants

The following entities located or operating in Pike County, Pennsylvania are eligible for this program:

- Municipalities
- Nonprofit organizations
- Businesses

Entities that have not received PPP or EIDL funds will be given priority.

Application Process

Applications will be received and reviewed on a rolling basis. Evaluation of applications and monitoring will be performed in accordance with 2 C.F.R. §§ 200.330 through 200.332.

*Requests for Reimbursement*

- Step 1: Online application is submitted along with receipts or paid invoices
- Step 2: Application is reviewed for eligibility by an independent firm within 5 business days of receipt
- Step 3: If the applicant and expenses are eligible under this program, County staff will issue a reimbursement

Reimbursement is not guaranteed and is subject to the eligibility criteria and the availability of funds.

Eligible Expenses

Eligible expenses are those that are both necessary and related to COVID-19. The following categories of expenses are eligible:

- Purchase of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) in response to pandemic such as masks or gloves
- Disinfectant supplies and/or cleaning company
- Equipment or shields needed to safely reopen

Expenses that have been or will be reimbursed by the federal or state government or any other entity are not eligible.
