

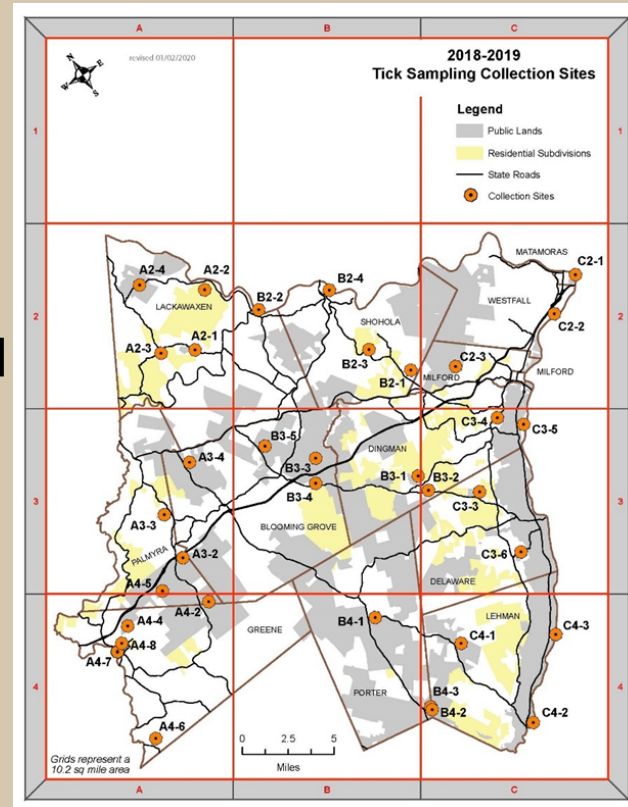
Pike County Tick Borne Disease Base Line Study

55.4%

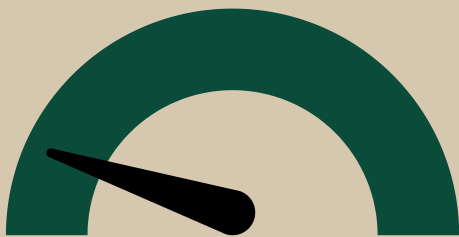
Results revealed that 55.40% of ticks tested were positive for at least one pathogen.

In May 2018, the Pike County Commissioners with assistance from the Pike County Tick Borne Diseases Task Force and the Dr. Jane Huffman Wildlife Genetics Institute started a countywide study of Blacklegged Ticks.

This study collected 1,000 Blacklegged Ticks and tested for seven known pathogens

123 of the 988 blacklegged ticks tested were carrying more than 1 pathogen/disease.
